This FREE event will feature hands-on art activities, refreshments and entertainment designed to encourage families to explore the museum and learn more about the artwork on display.



“I See 3-D” *Family Arts Day* will encourage visitors to further examine the current exhibitions on display, *Meredith Jack: Back in Black* and *This Rejection of the Conqueror: Works by Robert Pruitt*, both of which feature a selection of 3-dimensional pieces including metal sculptures and mixed-media installations and assemblages.
